LOCAL & NATIONAL CAMPAIGNING: With the emergence of alternative sites at Shell Haven, Felixstowe and Harwich, it has become absolutely clear that there is no overriding national need for a container port at Dibden Bay. In conjunction with the excellent Residents' organisation, I shall fight this development by continuing our campaign at Westminster as well as at County and Constituency levels.

Together with Desmond Swayne in New Forest West, I shall keep pressing for the new Lymington Hospital, and shall carefully monitor the proposed National Park status which Labour is imposing on the Forest. Desmond and I worked closely together in the last Parliament. Both of our voting records were amongst the highest of all Conservative MPs.

In some 50 Parliamentary speeches and several hundred Parliamentary questions, I have raised issues ranging from artificial limbs, mental health and mixed-sex wards, to student unions, voting systems, defence, intelligence and security. I was a leading opponent of the reduction of the homosexual age of consent from 18 to 16.
